Which of these techniques suits you best when working through the business theory?

Acrostics: “My Very Excellent Mother Just Served Us Nachos” (planets)

Flashcards: good for specific facts. Shuffle cards and recite out loud. Put a question on one side, the answer on the other

Mind Maps: draw diagrams for representing tasks, words, concepts, or items linked to and arranged around a central concept. Recite out loud in your own words until you don't need your notes. Teach someone else.

3. Practice. Practice once. Practice it twice... using the exam technique given you by your teacher

The best way to revise is through practice. You have all the questions and answers in Google classroom for each topic.. Working out a question will force you to revise the chapter anyway! Remember to always use Point, Application, Analyse technique you have followed since the beginning of the course.
