

The Saint Vincent de Paul Society is an organisation that the academy works closely with. Within the academy we have the Youth SVP (Year 7-11) and the SVP B-Attitude (Year 12 & 13).

The aim of these groups is to turn faith into action. Working together our students will be examples of how to live out the teaching of Christ in acts of charity. Our SVP groups work doing simple acts of charity that can make a huge difference to the lives of others. The other element of the group is to develop faith in Christ with opportunities to pray and reflect on who we are and what we do.

- **The B-Attitude** group was established in the academy in 2019 and is a group made up of our Sixth Form students. The students lead and guide the academy in developing spirituality through acts of faith and charity. There are leadership roles of Director, Assistant Director, Treasurer, Communications Officer and Secretary. The students work as leaders of the Youth SVP to organise opportunities to raise awareness, fundraise and develop our faith across all year groups.
