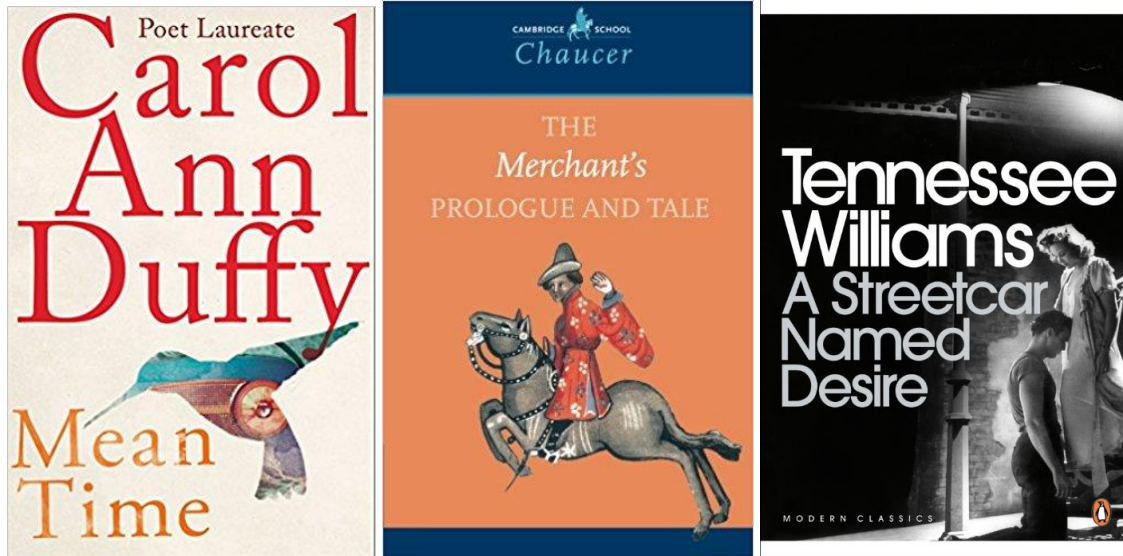


Key Stage 5 - A Level English Literature

Component 1 - Poetry

Component 2 - Drama

'A Streetcar Named Desire' by Tennessee Williams

Examination: (2hrs): 30% of qualification

Component 3 - Unseen Poetry & Prose

Students will be asked to analyse an unseen prose extract and a poem using the knowledge and skills they have acquired during their studies at A level.

Examination: (2hrs): 20% of qualification

Component 4 - Independent Course Work

Students will be required to write 2500 to 3500 words comparing two prose novels. One novel should be pre 1900 and the other post 2000. Students will receive guidance regarding this component during the course.
